



## Ms. Darendia Hardy

July 28, 1944 - January 26, 2018

Memorial services for Darendia Hardy, 73, of Henderson, will be held on Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at 2PM in the chapel of Crawford - A. Crim Funeral Home. Ms. Hardy passed away on January 26 in Henderson.

She was born on July 28, 1944 to the late Mr. John W. Hardy and Mary Lou (Lindsey) Hardy. She loved art, and was an artist as well, and after graduating with an Art History degree from Stephen F. Austin State University, she taught Art History in Waco. Ms. Hardy also served as President of Continental Airlines Flight Attendant's Association for over 20 years.
