



Mrs. Ada Long

December 20, 1923 - September 21, 2014

Ada Francis Long passed away from cancer at her home in Gary Texas on September 21, 2014. Ada was born in Tyler, Texas, December 20, 1923. She was the great-great granddaughter of an original Texas Ranger, Santiago Rabia.

Ada was the daughter of a master carpenter, Michael Conner and his wife Esta , who both preceded her in death. She grew up during the Great Depression, and as a result, throughout her life, had an aversion to throwing out leftovers. She was a woman of strong faith who met her husband of 52 years, Harry, in Dallas TX at a U.S.O. dance.

During World War II, she was one of the thousands of “Rosie The Riveters”, working in factories to support the war effort, while her husband was at war. After the war, she traveled the world and the country with her family, living in places like Iceland, Japan, Guam, and many of the states in the United States. During the 1970s and early 1980s Ada and her family lived in Myrtle Springs TX, where she was the kitchen manager at the Van Zandt County Country Club.

Ada and her family lived in Magalia, CA and Oroville, CA for some time, but moved to Mt. Enterprise, TX in 1992 where her husband passed away in 1994. Ada continued to live in Mt. Enterprise until 2013 when she moved to

Nacogdoches, TX. Recently, she moved to Gary, TX to live with her daughter, Lura.

Ada was preceded in death by her husband, Harry, her brother, George, and her son, Johnny. Ada is survived by her daughter, Lura, and two sons, Terry and Michael. Ada leaves a legacy of four grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and five great-great-grandchildren.

Ada was a devout Catholic and her services will be held at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Nacogdoches, TX, on Saturday, September 27, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. She will be buried at Myrtle Springs Cemetery (located on County Road 3442, off of Interstate 20) next to her husband and her parents.

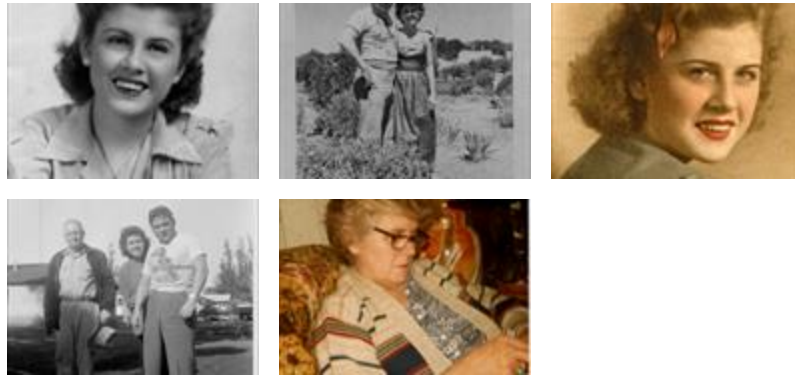

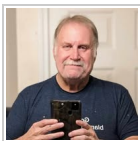
