Mrs. Schmidt passed from this life on May 18, 2015 in Tyler. She was born July 29, 1952 in Henderson to Earl Hudson and the late Ruby (Irwin) Hudson and was a life long resident of Henderson. Mrs. Schmidt retired from Henderson I.S.D. after 20 plus years as a 5th grade teacher at Northside. She loved her son Ed, daughter-in-law Denise, grandchildren and her students. When asked which student had been her favorite she would simply reply "all of them." Mrs. Schmidt was also an active member of First Baptist Church in Henderson until her health permitted otherwise.

She was preceded in death by her mother Ruby Hudson, and her sister JaJuana Devron.

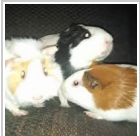
