



Mr. B.L. (Dick) Creel

Boyd Lewis (Dick) Creel, 88, of Mt. Enterprise, passed away Thursday, December 3, 2015 at Autumn Leaves in Henderson. He was born March 18, 1927 in Jacksonville, Texas to Marvin Israel Creel and Monnie Lawler Creel.

Dick graduated from Mt. Enterprise High School and served his country during World War II in the US Navy from September 1944-July 1946. He was married to Mary Elizabeth Putman Creel on June 25, 1947 until her death March 11, 2012. He was self-employed as owner of Creel's Radio & TV for many years until his retirement. He was a faithful member of Landmark Baptist Church in Mt. Enterprise and was a past school board member at Mt. Enterprise ISD. He was "Pa" to his grandchildren and great grandchildren.
