She then spent a career in education, retiring as an English professor at Kilgore College. In her spare time and then retirement, Mrs. Read enjoyed traveling and bird watching, and she was a member of the Henderson Women's Forum. Barbara was a long time member of the Henderson Seventh Day Adventist Church where she served as church pianist for nearly 30 years.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 44 years, Wally Read; and a brother, Donald C. Harris.

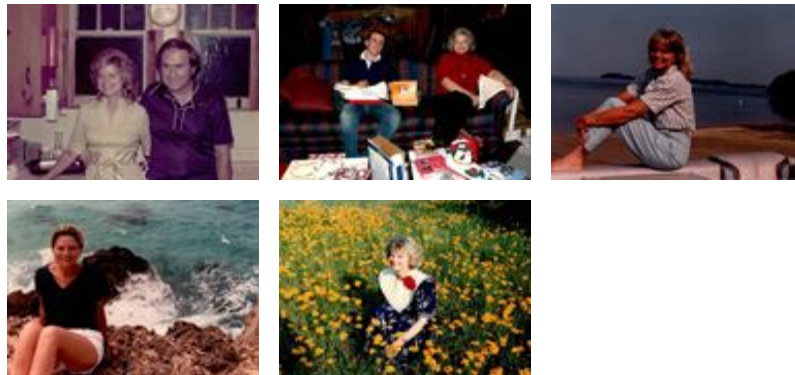
