Mrs. Beverly Ann Pobuda, 78, of Oak Hill, passed from this life on May 2, 2025, at her residence. She was born November 4, 1946, in Shreveport, Louisiana to the late Douglas James Beggerly and Dorothy Faye Beggerly.
