



Rev. Bill Tisdale

January 8, 1929 - September 24, 2014

Billy Bob Tisdale, 85, of Henderson, Texas, beloved husband and best friend of Helen

(McWilliams) Tisdale, went to his home in glory on September 24, 2014 surrounded by family.

Bill was born January 8, 1929 in El Dorado, Arkansas to Albert and Stella (Albritton) Tisdale. Growing up in Selman City, TX, he graduated from Gaston High School in Joinerville, TX

in 1946. After high school he attended Kilgore Junior College and then completed his

bachelor's degree in business administration at his beloved University of Texas at Austin where he graduated in 1950.

After college, Bill began work for Hunt Oil Company. While driving a pipe truck in the

West Texas oil fields, he was involved in an accident on August 17, 1950, resulting in the

loss of an arm. He continued working for Hunt Oil until 1952 after a period of recovery and rehabilitation.

Bill married Helen McWilliams of Joinerville, TX on January 26, 1952. In October of that year, Bill answered God's call upon his life to serve in ministry

and he entered Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in the autumn of 1953, graduating with a Master of Divinity degree in 1955.

After pastoring two churches in Oklahoma and Texas, Bill felt the call to missions and was appointed as a Southern Baptist foreign missionary to the Philippines where he served for 15 years as a church planner and evangelist. Living in the city of Tarlac on the island of Luzon, God richly blessed Bill and Helen's ministry among the Filipino people whom they so dearly loved.

He returned to the pastorate in 1970 and was called to serve a young Baptist church on the eastern border of Dallas. The timing of Bill's calling was providential and in the nine years he pastored Casa View Baptist, the Church experienced remarkable physical and spiritual growth. Dozens of young people answered God's call to ministry and many came to know Christ as Savior.

In 1979, the voices of the Filipino people would be heard again and so Bill accepted an appointment as Director of Church Growth and Evangelism for the Philippines. He served until 1983 when he returned to the States to accept his last pastorate.

Serving as Pastor of First Baptist Church of Henderson, TX, had always been a distant dream for Bill. Henderson represented the heart of East Texas -- the county of his boyhood, just down the road from where he lettered in sports at Gaston, where he met his only love of 62 years, near the McWilliams homestead, where they married in the Cumberland Presbyterian Church- it was a return to his roots and ultimately, the place where he would retire. He pastored at First Henderson for ten years and led the church to unprecedented growth.

Bill loved hunting, fishing, people, his Texas Longhorns, and laughter. He had

a quiet respect and deep love for the Land; and whether it was fishing the farm ponds of East Texas or quail hunting on the West Texas plains, he appreciated the beauty of the earth.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents Albert and Stella, his sisters Velma Coffey, Eunice Phillips, Mildred Stewart, and Geneva Beggs.

Bill is survived by his wife Helen, his four children Mark (Debi) Tisdale, Becky (John) Dickson, Pam (Johnny) Funderburg, and Paul (Judy) Tisdale, his nine grandchildren April, Nathan, Lauren, Matthew, David, Kristin, Andrew, Ryan, and Abigail, four great grandchildren, his brothers Donald and A. J. Tisdale, his sister Marie Abney, and numerous nieces and nephews. Bill was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend to all. He never met a stranger.

A memorial service will be held at First Baptist Church of Henderson, TX on Saturday, October 4th at 2 p.m. A reception will follow in the Family Life Center.

A private burial will be at Lakewood Cemetery. Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home will manage all arrangements.

“ *Pastor Bill and Helen and their young family first came to the Philippines to respond to the pressing need to minister to US servicemen and their families who were stationed at Clark Air Base. It didn't take them very long to discover, however, that God wanted them and two other Southern Baptist missionary families to pioneer Baptist work in 3 adjacent provinces where they lived. Today, SB churches in that area are not only continually multiplying, but are also among the strongest churches in the land.*

The late 1950s through the early 1970s were perhaps the hardest times to preach the Gospel, let alone plant a non-Catholic church in that part of our country. Catholics were being warned that it was a mortal sin even just to enter a non-Catholic church. The local Communists saw the missionaries and preachers as a major hindrance to their ungodly message also. And the build-up of materialism, vices and ungodliness that was wrought by the mere presence of the US airbase in Pampanga stifled much of our gospel efforts during those early days.

Thank God for the boldness and dedication of the likes of pioneers such as Pastor Bill and Helen of Tarlac, Allen and Frankie Smith of Pampanga and Ed and Audrey Gordon of Pangasinan! Their bold preaching of God's Word and their faithful equipping of the saints have laid a very strong foundation for the Southern Baptist ministry there that continues to flourish today!
