Billy Joe Holland, 81, of Henderson, passed away Wednesday, June 15, 2011 at home after a short illness. He was born in Hickey, Tx in 1930, graduated from Henderson High School in 1949, and from Stephen F. Austin State University in 1957. He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Billy Joe enjoyed a highly successful business career, attaining several management positions during a 35 year career with General Electric. He began that career in Houston, then he and his family moved to Seattle, Washington, Anaheim, California, and finally to San Antonio. He retired from GE in 1991, and moved back to Henderson. In addition to his business career and family, Billy Joe enjoyed golfing, hunting, reading and fishing. He was a member of the Henderson Country Club for many years, and also a member of First United Methodist Church in Henderson. He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Malee; daughter Melanie Oseland and son-in-law Bruce Oseland; daughter Brigett Bertamini and son-in-law Stefano Bertamini; and grandchildren Laura Oseland, Tessa, Brett and Brennan Bertamini.
