



Ms. Blanch E. Maynard

Ms. Maynard passed from this life on December 29, 2017, at Good Shepherd Medical Center in Longview. She was born April 11, 1936, in Rusk County to the late Horace and Lilliar (Collier) Maynard and spent most all of her life in Rusk County. Blanch was a 1954 graduate of Gaston High School and attended North Texas Teacher's College, now the University of North Texas, in Denton. She went on to work as a secretary for the American Red Cross in Dallas for 10 years. Ms. Maynard was an avid animal lover and a wonderful cook. She was also very creative and quite artistic. She held certificates in floral arranging, cake baking, and was a gifted seamstress who could make clothing that looked better than what you could find in a store. Blanch was also a CNA and a certified sitter and used those skills to care for the sick and elderly, especially family. She grew up as a member of Cumberland Presbyterian Church where she was later nominated as an elder for life by the Presbyterian Council.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by brothers Kenneth and Homer Maynard, sisters Vivian Satterwhite and Maudie Williams, and nephews Michael Arden, Paul Maynard, and William Lee Maynard.
