Mrs. Bonnie Marie Abernathy Jones of Beeville, Texas, went to be with her Lord on Wednesday, October 16, 2013. She was greeted by her husband of 64 years – Homer Jefferson Jones.

She was born in Panola County to William T. and Gertice Abernathy on August 3, 1918. They preceded her in death. Also preceding her were her brothers, George Abernathy and Quentin Abernathy, a sister, Epsie Lee (Richard) Hull, and her son-in-laws parents, Monroe and Emma Finke.
