Mr. Propes passed away June 12, 2012 in Tyler. He was born March 21, 1924 in Henderson to the late Marvin A. and Mittie Pearl Winfrey Propes and spent most of his life in Rusk County. Mr. Propes was World War II veteran of the US Navy and was a Chief Petty Officer 1st Class on the USS Lexington when it sank in the Coral Sea. He also served on the USS Saratoga. Mr. Propes was a Colonel on Gov. John Bell Williams' court in Jackson, MS in 1968, and he was a member of the Hamasa Temple in Meridian, MS. He was the national account executive for Lamb Rental Tools by trade, and he was a Boy Scout troop leader and loved playing golf. Mr. Propes was a 32nd degree Mason in the Clinton Lodge and was a Shriner. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Henderson.
