



## Mr. Carroll Thompson

September 3, 1955 - September 28, 2015

Memorial services for Mr. Carroll Thompson, 60, of Henderson, formerly of Humble, will be at 11:00 a.m., Thursday, Oct. 1, 2015 at the South Main Church of Christ Fellowship Hall with Brother Bob Payne officiating.

Mr. Thompson passed away Monday, Sept. 28, 2015 at his residence. He was born Sept. 3, 1955 in Houston and had lived in Humble for 46 years before moving to Henderson in 2012.
