



Coach Joe Clint Skelton

August 6, 1930 - June 9, 2012

Funeral services for Mr. Joe Skelton, 81, of Henderson, will be held at 10 a.m. Monday, June 11, 2012 in the chapel of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home with Rev. Randy Sceroler and Rev. Bill Tisdale officiating. Interment will follow in Duncan Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Family will receive friends from 2-4 p.m. Sunday, June 10 at the funeral home. Joe Clint Skelton was born August 6, 1930 in Henderson to mother Hattie Propes Skelton and father Otis Whitman Skelton. Joe was a lifelong resident of Henderson and a member of First Baptist Church. He was baptized in Christ as a young man and always lived a good Christian life. Mr. Skelton was a graduate of Henderson High School, Kilgore Junior College, and Stephen F. Austin State University. He served in the National Guard and was a coach for the Henderson Independent School District for 37 years where he was a positive influence in the lives of everyone who knew and loved him. He will be greatly missed. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by: older brothers, Otis W. Skelton Jr. and James G. Skelton; and sister, Dorothy Atkinson; and his faithful dog, Max.
