Military Graveside services for Lt. Col. Doug Beggerly, 87, of Oak Hill, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2009, at Oak Hill Cemetery with Rev Ted White officiating. Col. Beggerly died Saturday, Oct. 31, 2009 at his residence. He was born Oct. 16, 1922 in Houston, Texas and had lived in Henderson since 1968. He was a retired Lt.Col. in the U.S. Air Force. Col. Beggerly began his military service by enlisting in 1940 and was an aerial gunner in the B-18's and B-17's, flying combat missions in the Australian Pacific. Then was selected for pilot training and flying support missions for the Flying Tigers and other Allied forces in China-Burma-India. In Korea he flew night combat low level attack missions in the B26's, credited with destroying 6 enemy locomotives and several supply trains. In Vietnam he flew B-57's giving close air support in the south and interdiction in North Vietnam. His combat awards include the Silver Star, 2 Distinguished Flying Crosses, and over 20 Air Medals. He was also awarded several Campaign and Service medals. After retiring from the military he worked for Anderson Hickey Inc. in a Management position for 18 years here in Henderson. Col. Beggerly was Commander of the Commemorative Air Force Lone Star Wing, Member of the East Texas Vintage Auto Club, Tyler Model A Club, Optimist Club, a Mason, Former Chairman of the Rusk County Democratic Party, and active with the Henderson Chamber of Commerce. He was preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Faye Beggerly. Survivors include: sons, Jim Beggerly and wife, Brenda of Tyler, Scott Beggerly and wife, Brenda of Oak Hill; daughters, Bev

Pobuda and husband, Ken of Ohio and Cindy Pruett of Henderson; sister Mary K. Longnecker of Ft. Worth; 8 grandchildren ; 14 great-grandchildren. Pallbearers will be the Air Force.
