Mrs. Connie Rae Boatwright Conner, 63, of Cañon City, Colorado, formerly of Henderson, passed from this life on April 22, 2021, at her residence surrounded by her loving family.

Mrs. Conner was born November 13, 1957, in Henderson to the late Lloyd L. and Joyce (Green) Boatwright. 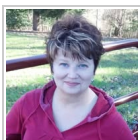
