He continued his work with TP&L, which later became Texas Utilities, and retired from there after 42 years, having been his only place of employment.

Curtis loved his family, deer hunting, raising cattle, and outside of church, he was rarely seen without a cap and/or camouflage! Curtis loved traveling to the mountains of Colorado and to the Texas Hill Country, and had countless trips there with Kim, his family, and his hunting buddies. Curtis had a hidden talent for landscape photography, and has an array of beautiful shots of those favorite places. Curtis was a loyal Texas Rangers fan, and their recent World Series Championship brought some happiness to his hard days of battling cancer.
