Mr. Cummings passed away July 28, 2020 in Henderson. He was born August 12, 1924 in Lebanon, Oregon to the late Milo Elam and Ruby Pearl Lawrence Cummings. He served his country in The United States Army Air Corp in the Pacific Theater during World War II. He was stationed in India and "flew the hump" in a B-24 over the Himalaya Mountains into China to deliver fuel to American and Chinese troops. He moved to Henderson in 1958 and worked as an electrical linesman for Rusk County Electric Coop until his retirement. He was a faithful member of South Main Church of Christ.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Milo and Ruby Cummings; wife, Edna Cummings; brothers, Milo Cummings Jr., Layton Cummings; and sister, Pat Palla.
