Funeral services for David Blanton, 64, of Laneville, will be held at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home Chapel at 2 pm, Friday, October 14, 2011 with the Reverend David Luckert officiating. Burial will follow at Laneville Cemetery. Visitation will be from 12:00 pm to 2 pm, on Friday, at the funeral home. David was born in Henderson, Texas on October 9, 1947, and died at his home on October 11, 2011. He was raised in Laneville and graduated from Henderson High School in 1965. He excelled in many sports, particularly football, where he achieved all- district and all-state honors. He attended Kilgore College and Stephen F. Austin State University. He was a member of the First Baptist Church in Laneville. David served as a Rusk County deputy sheriff for 8 years and retired from Texas Utilities after twenty-five years. He was a member of the Board of Directors for EastTex Telephone Co-op. He also had a successful dirt work and heavy equipment business. Additionally, he enjoyed his cattle operation and his grandson Rex. He was a true cowboy to the core - rider, roper, and the real deal. He was preceded in death by his mother, Faye Irwin Blanton; his father, Curtis Blanton; and several aunts and uncles.
