Mr. Wimberly passed away July 10, 2020 at Hospice of East Texas in Tyler. He was born Oct. 4, 1949 in Huntingdon, TN, and lived for 40 years in Troup. "Duck," as he was affectionately called, owned and operated Wimberly Trucking for 30 years. He married the love of his life, Teri, on Dec. 25, 1991 and they blended their families together. 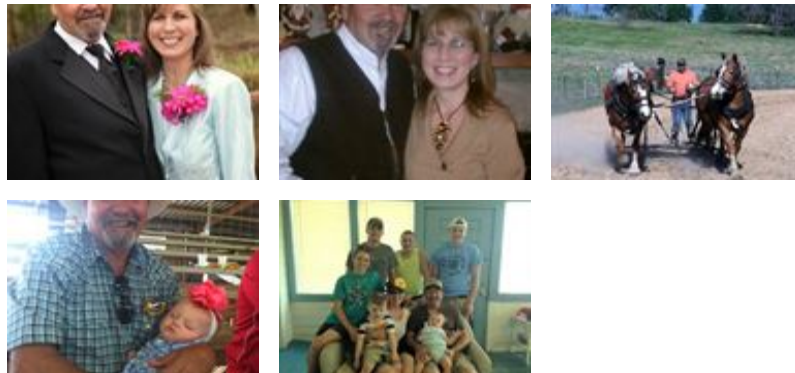
