



Mr. Donnie Howeth

Funeral services for Mr. Donnie Howeth, 77, of Henderson, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 31, 2020, in the chapel at Crawford-A. 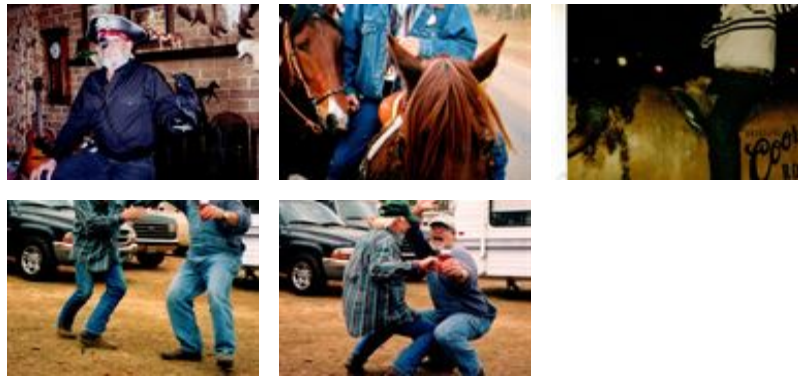

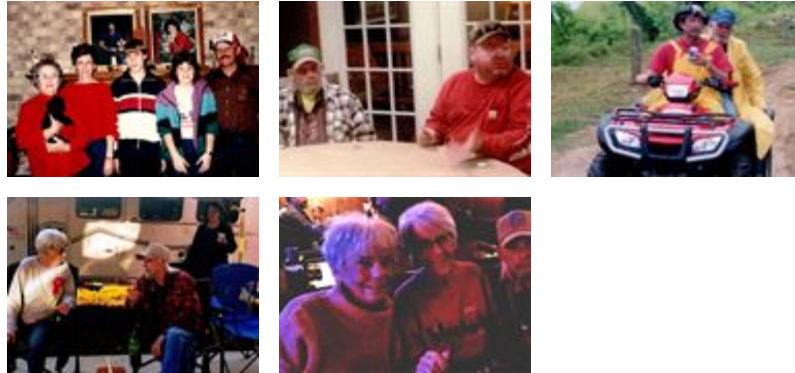

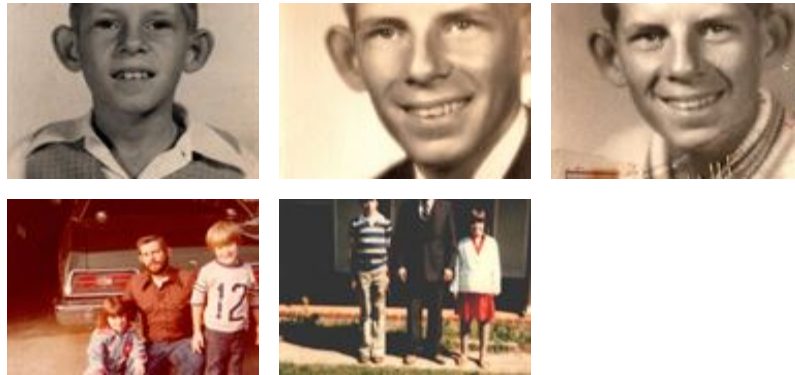
