Douglas Banks Stone, 91, of Henderson passed away on Tuesday, May 12, 2015 at Autumn Leaves Nursing and Rehabilitation under the care of Heart to Heart Hospice. Douglas was born June 14, 1923 in Santo, TX to Early Andrew and Chloe Banks Stone. Douglas was one of two survivors of his 8th grade class in the New London School Explosion on March 18, 1937. Douglas played running back on the New London Wildcats football team and graduated in 1942. Douglas married the love of his life, Tommie Louise Machen, on July 4, 1942. Douglas served in the Navy from 1942-1945 as a Ships Serviceman L3rd class and was stationed in Hawaii. Douglas worked several different jobs over the years and retired from Texas Eastman on June 1, 1985. Douglas and his wife, Tommie, loved traveling and ballroom dancing. Douglas was a member of the New London Methodist Church for many years.
