



Mr. Doyle Moore

February 6, 1935 - May 17, 2022

Funeral services for Mr. Doyle Moore, 87, of Chalk Hill, will be held at 2:00 p.m., on Saturday, May 21, 2022, at Bar None Cowboy Church with Jason Taylor and Joe Cox officiating. Interment will follow at Chalk Hill Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

The family will receive friends from 1:00 p.m. until service time on Saturday, May 21, 2022, at the church.

Mr. Moore passed from this life on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 in Tyler. He was born on February 6, 1935, to the late Claude D. and Mary Jane Melton Moore in Seminole, Oklahoma.

Doyle was a truck driver for over 40 years. He traveled cross-country and was noted to have driven over three million miles logged without an accident.

Doyle was a member of Bar None Cowboy Church where he served in many areas. He was one of the original builders of the church in 2007 and continued to use his carpenter skills as the church expanded. He was a member of the facility team where he faithfully tended to the grounds and kept the outside maintained for many years then moved to the kitchen team. Every Sunday you could find Doyle at his post, greeting and serving members with a smile and a cool glass of tea. But he was known most for his ability to turn trash into

treasure with his scrap metal ministry. Doyle would collect any and all scrap metal that was left over from various projects, sort through and organize. He would find the scrap metal yard that paid the most that week and trade those scraps for a return. He would then give the funds back to the church to help with various missions. Doyle used his talents and served the Lord wholeheartedly. His commitment and hard work were inspiring to those who knew him.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers, Earnest Moore and William Moore; and sisters, Ruby Geffert, Jewel Geffert, and Veva Ford.

Survivors include his wife of 61 years, Mickey Moore of Chalk Hill; daughters, Dee Stephens of Henderson and Judy Campos and husband Raymond of Aransas Pass, TX; brothers, Wayne Moore and wife Helen of Waco and Dale Moore and wife Donna of Oklahoma City, OK; sisters, Jean Jordan of Ft. Worth and Eleanor Skidmore and husband Max of Springfield, MO; grandchildren, Caleb Stephens, Jordan Stephens both of Henderson, Andrew Valdez II and wife Amanda of Craigsville, IN, and Jason Valdez and wife Desiree of Carlsbad, CA; and three great-grandchildren.

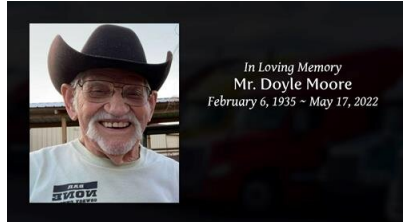
