



Mr. E. A. "Bubba" Edge

Graveside services with military honors for Mr. E. A. "Bubba" Edge, 65, of Tatum, will be at 11:00 a.m., Saturday, Dec. 2, 2017 at Tatum Cemetery with Ralph Edge officiating. Interment will follow under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home of Henderson.

Mr. Edge passed away November 29, 2017, at his residence. He was born Sept. 24, 1952 in Tatum. He served in the US Marine Corps from 1972-1976, during which time he was stationed as an embassy guard in Paris, France. He worked for the USPS as a postal clerk, and also as a dispatcher for 8 years with Cox Refrigerated Express in Dallas. Bubba loved his Tatum Eagles, and also loved farming his cream peas, and watching his son race at the dirt track.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Margie and Mack Young, and Eddie Edge.
