Mr. Taylor was born August 15, 1935, In the Dirgin community of Rusk County, to the late E.A. Taylor and Ann Young Taylor. After graduating from Tatum High School in 1957, Mr. Taylor was drafted into the United States Army. When he returned home in 1960, he worked at Trailmobile, Inc., in Longview, TX. In 1965, he began a new career with Texas Eastman as a welder and retired after 30 years in 1995. He was a member of Stewart Free Will Baptist Church and a member of the Tatum Masonic Lodge.
