She worked at Rusk County Library and Gas Ration Board during WWII. She retired from Sears after 36 years as credit manager and also retired from Trinity Mother Frances after 29 years. Henderson News recognized her as "Henderson's own Earth Angel." She enjoyed traveling to Hawaii, Aruba, Branson and Arkansas. She was a member of the Eastern Star for 50 years. She married Rufus Phillips May 5, 1938.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Rufus Phillips, sister Margie Nay and great-great-nephew Jaxen Boothe.

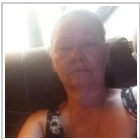

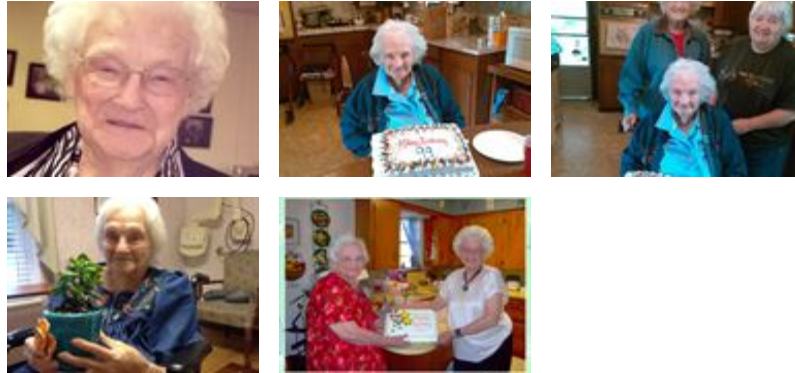
