Eldon W. Farmer, 97, of Gilmer, was born February 25, 1925. He was one of six children born to Currie Farmer and Mabel Davis Farmer, Neva, Clara, Mary, Doyle and Eugene, all born at their family home in Maryville, Missouri. Eldon graduated from Rosendale High School in Rosendale, Missouri in 1943 where he was one of the star players of their winning football team. Mr. Farmer passed from this life on July 22, 2022, in Gilmer.

He served his country during World War II in the U.S. Army, taking his basic training at Camp Fannin in Tyler, Texas before being shipped to Japan with the 600th Air Engineer Squadron where he served for 2 years.

He retired as V.P, from Custom Commodities in Gilmer. He taught truck driving to new drivers, was the insurance adjuster, compliance officer and office manager. He was a gentleman farmer, he dearly loved bailing hay, it truly was his passion. He and his wife Jo built their house, barn & shop while raising a heard of Black Angus cattle, the family horse Boudreaux and Australian Shepherd, Bonnie Blue as well as Turkey's, Geese and Quail. He loved his spring fed lake (Farmer Lake) which was well stocked with Catfish and a fishing pier full of tackle for friends to come enjoy.

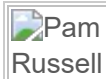

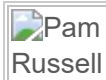
