(Whit) and Bentie Mae Copeland Yandle and died on June 27, 2011 after an eleven year battle with cancer. She graduated from Henderson High School in 1941 and attended one year of business college. Mrs. Crawford worked for Civil Service for several years during World War II at Midland Air Force Base and met and married Lt. David Webb, a pilot in the U.S. Air Force who was killed over Germany and is buried on Normandy Beach. She returned to Henderson in 1946 and married her high school sweetheart, James Crawford and they lived in Beckville for twenty-five years where they were always active in the church and community. Her two sons were born to this union, Jim and John Crawford. Mrs. Crawford became a Registered Medical Records Administrator and worked at Panola General Hospital in Carthage for twenty-five years. She loved football and all sports and saw many games that her son coached. She lived to see both of her sons, her three grandsons, and this past year saw her great-grandson play football. After retirement and moving back to Henderson she worked for John Foster, J.R. Patterson, and Clay

Wilder.Mrs. Crawford was preceded in death by: parents, L.W. (Whit) and Bentie Mae Copeland Yandle; grandparents, J.W. and Clara Maude Copeland, and Johnny and Janie Brown Yandle; and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.Survivors include: two sons, James W. Crawford and wife Linda of Beckville, and John R. Crawford and wife Cheryl of Colleyville; grandsons, Jamie Crawford and wife Estela of Longview, Jason Crawford and wife Amanda of Mesquite, and Jerod Crawford and wife Kristen of Benbrook; eight great-grandchildren, Vanessa, Moreno, Trevor, Trenton, Bryson, Kade, Riley, and Lila Crawford; also fourteen Copeland first cousins, other relatives, and many friends.She was a member of First United Methodist Church, the PALS Sunday School Class, and United Methodist Women.
