At the age of 47, she became a Licensed Vocational Nurse. She worked for 20 years and retired from Henderson Memorial Hospital. She loved nursing, but nursing ran second to her love for her Husband, Pete. She and Pete were married on September 10, 1938. They were inseparable. They seldom took vacations and seldom ate out. They liked the simple things in life. They loved each other's company and that of their family. Although they had no children of their own, they had plenty of nephews and nieces that filled their lives with joy. They were married 66 years until his death in 2004. After Pete's death and until the day she died, she will always be remembered for making her decisions based on what Pete would do. How many times has the family heard her say, "Pete and I never did that" or "Pete and I always voted this way." Our family laughs about that often. Jewel loved her kitchen. She loved cooking every meal for her husband. Every year you could find her putting up her fig preserves and cucumber pickles that were raised in her back yard. If you visited Jewel, you couldn't leave until you had your jars of figs and pickles. Jewel was preceded in death by her parents,

Owen W. and Eva Mae Williamson; her husband of 66 years, Preston (Pete) Young; half brothers, Emmett W. Waits and Clifford Angus Waits; a half sister, Ruby Waits Sharp; brothers Alma D. Williamson, Eddie Williamson, and Edwin R. Williamson; and one sister, Evie Mae Price. She was also preceded in death by several brother-in-laws and sister-in-laws.
