



Mr. Euel Mays Faulkner

Funeral services for Euel Mays Faulkner, 92, of Henderson, will be held at 2:00 p.m., Monday, January 10, 2022 with visitation at 1:00 p.m. both at Crawford-A. Crim chapel with Thomas Monroe officiating. Interment will follow at Liberty Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

Euel Mays Faulkner peacefully went into the arms of his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ early morning of January 6, 2022 after a brief illness. He was surrounded by his loving family at home. Euel was born April 19, 1929 in the Liberty Community to parents Morgan and Velma Faulkner.

He was a life long resident of Rusk County. He married the love of his life, Barbara Watson seventy-one years ago. Euel served in the United States Army during the Korean conflict in Germany as a radio operator. His faith was the most important aspect of his life, and he was a witness to all who knew him.

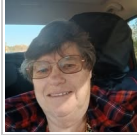

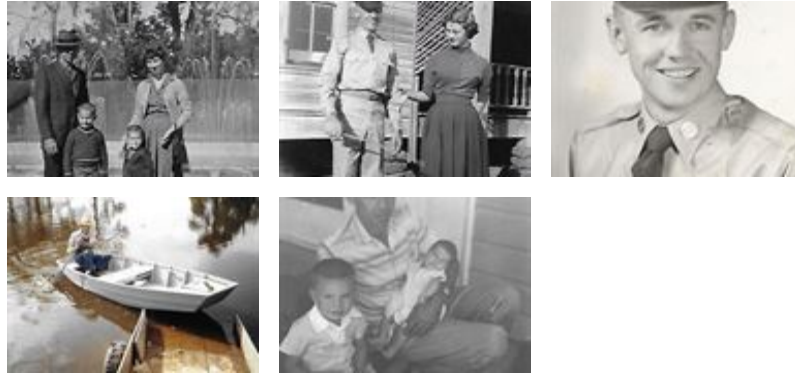
