She was preceded in death by her father Melvin Cole, mother and stepfather Bessie and Harold Mefford, and her brother David Mefford.

Survivors include her husband of over 40 years, James Jester of Overton; son, George Allen "Big'Un" Stanley and wife Gail of Turnertown; grandchildren, Stephanie Young and Vonnie Mitchum; great-grandchildren,

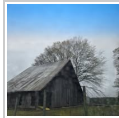
