A memorial visitation for Mr. Garry David Gladden, 59, of Good Springs, will be held Friday, January 27, 2017, from 6 pm to 8 pm at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. 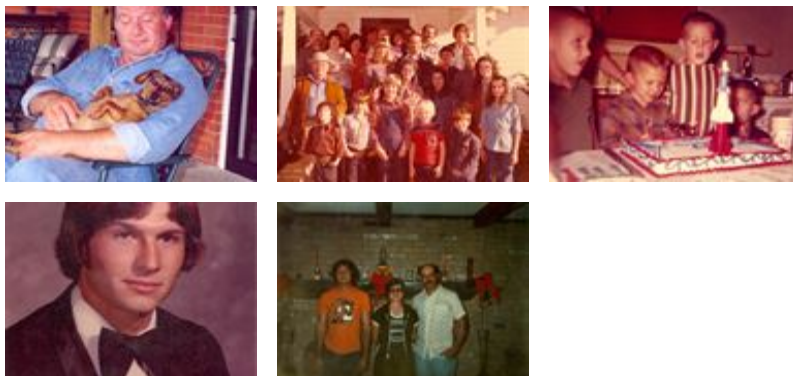
