He was a proud member of the National Rifle Association, and his hobbies included fishing and hunting but his main hobby was beagles. He raised, trained, and competed with gun dog beagles for over 40 years of his life. His greatest achievement was being nominated and voted into the SPO Gundog Beagle Hall of Fame in 2009 by his peers from across the U.S.. He was inducted in 2010 at the AKC SPO Nationals awards banquet in Kentucky. Mr. Hanks was retired from Hi-Tec Pet Food and was a member of the United Pentacostal Church of Carlisle. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Brett Hanks. Survivors include: wife, Charlene Hanks of Price; sons, Marc Hanks of Bonham and Thomas Chad Hanks of Price; brother, Leroy Hanks of Tyler; sisters, Dorothy Poe of Longview, Elizabeth Doss of Tyler, and Kay Payne of Dallas; and three grandchildren.
