George Edwin Wilson, 75, of Henderson, passed away peacefully on Friday, April 21 at the East Texas Hospice in Tyler. He was born in Kilgore, Texas on October 27, 1941, to the late Graham and Myrtle Collins Wilson. George was his Momma's pride and joy and has been awaiting his arrival in Heaven.

George graduated from Carlisle High School in 1959. He attended Kilgore College and Lamar University where he received a Chemical Engineering degree in 1963. He began his engineering career at Cities Services Oil Company. In 1973, he went into private business and owned White Auto Services in St. Francisville, LA, and in Atlanta, TX. In 1979, he returned to engineering and worked for Mitchell Energy in Bridgeport and Ft. Worth as a Superintendent of Drilling before retiring in 1998. He and Ladean moved "back home" to Henderson in 1999.

He was the loving father of two daughters, Dayna Wilson Cox of North Richland Hills, Texas, and Aimee Wilson Morris (Greg) of Whitehouse. be hard-working, honest, and grateful.

He enjoyed fishing, classic cars, playing baseball, traveling with his family, riding his motorcycle, working or piddling in his shop wearing his signature overalls, his many stray dogs, and supporting his grandchildren in all their endeavors.
