



## Mr. Gerald W. Allmon

April 22, 1936 - February 17, 2014

A Memorial Service to celebrate the life of Mr. Gerald Wayne Allmon, 77, of Henderson will be held at 1:30 p.m., Monday, February 24, 2014 at First United Methodist Church with Rev. David Luckert officiating.

Mr. Allmon passed away peacefully February 17, 2014 in Tyler after a courageous battle with cancer. He was born April 22, 1936 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri to Harley and Alma Allmon. After earning a ceramic engineering degree at the Rolla School of Mines and Metal-lurgy, Gerald went to work for Henderson Clay Products in 1958 until his retirement in 1997.

Expression of his love for God through music was an integral part of Gerald's life. He treasured his time as a member of the Crim Gospel Singers, Gloryland Vocal Band, and the First United Methodist Church Choir and Praise Team. He was also a faithful servant of the church since 1958, teaching his Sunday School class up until a few weeks ago. In retirement, Gerald thoroughly enjoyed his work as the maintenance go-to man for Johnny Walker. His friendly smile, thoughtful & kind gestures, and steadfast faith were an inspiration to all who knew him.
