Mr. Glen W. McRae, 89, of the Liberty Community lay down his head for a nap on Friday, June 21, 2013 and awoke with his Savior, Lord Jesus Christ. He was welcomed in Heaven by his wife of 64 years, Adelle, his parents Fred and Ana Lou McRae, and grandson, Joseph McRae. Glen was born March 12, 1924 in Rusk County. He accepted his Savior at the young age of 16 while plowing a field. He served our country during WWII before returning to East Texas. Glen and Adelle married in 1942. They kept it a secret for a year. His Dad finally asked him "When are you gonna bring that pretty girl by". Glen retired from LeTourneau and he and his wife settled down for a life of farming, ranching, and bee-keeping and playing with their grandchildren in the Liberty Community.

Glen is survived in death by his two sons and their wives, Donnie and Pam McRae of Henderson, and Freddie and Linda McRae of Village Mills; five grandchildren, Dawn McRae, Mandy McRae, Jason and wife Sarah McRae, Chad and wife Kristin McRae, all of Henderson, and Josh and wife Kristen McRae of Round Rock; seven great-grandchildren, Cullen Stokes, Katie Stokes, Colton McRae, Gracie Decker, Cannon McRae, Scarlet McRae, and Joey McRae; and great-great-grandchild, Mavrik Stokes.

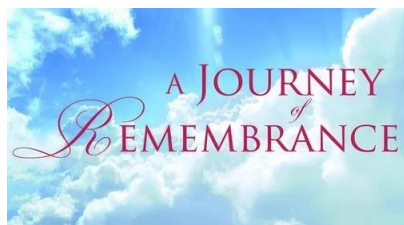
