



## Mrs. Gwen Sheffield

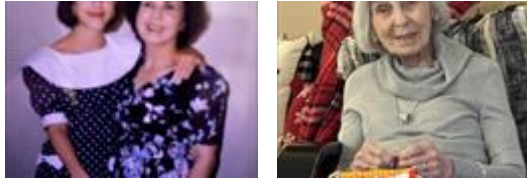
