Mr. Linthicum passed away November 14, 2020, at UT Health in Henderson. He was born October 25, 1932 in New Salem to the late John Hollis and Pearlie Mae (Costlow) Linthicum. He was a 1951 graduate of Henderson High School. Mr. Linthicum served his country in the United States Air Force. On September 14, 1951 he married the love of his life, Mary Elizabeth "Beth" Compton. He moved to Houston in 1955 and worked as a control room operator for Rohm & Haas Chemical Plant. In 1974, he and his family moved back to New Salem where he became a rancher and farmer. He was a member of BBA and several other Cattle Associations. He was a faithful member of the New Salem Church of Christ, Highway 79 Church of Christ in Henderson, and Southside Church of Christ in Jacksonville.
