Mr. Daugherty passed away on June 22, 2018, at his residence. He was born July 9, 1946 in Henderson and retired from Texas Utilities after 28 years of service. Jackie loved fishing and playing with his grandchildren, and playing 42 with family and friends. He was an accomplished bass guitar player, being self-taught at the age of 13. After the service Jack introduced himself and his family, Linda, and his two daughters, Dana and Angela. It just so happened our kids were the same age and shared many of the same interests. Angela and Carrie, my daughter, grew up best friends and so did my daughter Amy and Dana. Also we really hit it off well and found out Jack was a master bass guitar player (probably the best I've ever heard) and when he asked if I was interested in doing some Christian music in a band together I jumped at the opportunity. Jack was so talented and played in many other bands as well because he loved all kinds of music. Over the next twenty five or so years we went up and down the roads together dragging our families all the way.
