



Mr. James L. "Jimmie" Chambless

Mr. Chambless passed from this life on Friday, October 30, 2020, at Hospice Homeplace in Tyler. He was born October 31, 1935, in Hamilton, to the late Verner and Lula (Lawson) Chambless and spent most of his life in Henderson. "Jimmie", along with his father Verner, owned and operated Chambless Implement Sales and dealt in Ford tractors. He later held the position of Sanitation Superintendent with the city of Henderson and went on to retire from Rusk County Electric Co-Op. Mr. Chambless also served his country in the Army National Guard.

Jimmie was a hard-working man, and in his spare time, he enjoyed yardwork and landscaping. He was a family-oriented man, a dedicated husband and father, and he so enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren. Mr. Chambless was most definitely a people person. He made friends easily and

often and was well liked among his many friends and acquaintances. Jimmie was also a long-time member of the Henderson Church of Christ.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Joyce Chambless; infant twin sister, Verna Lu Nell Chambless; and sister, Judy Sprott.

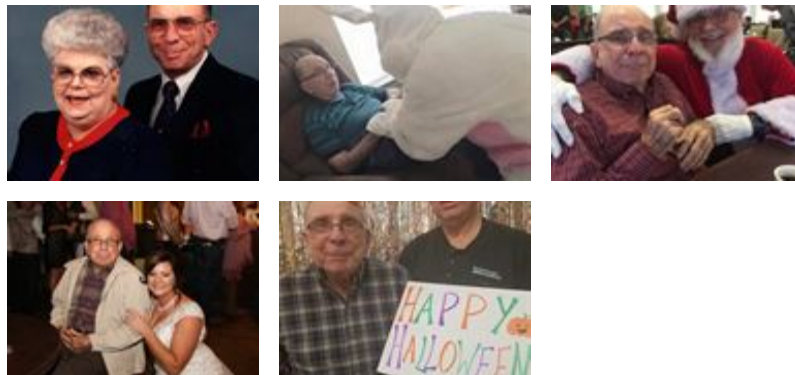

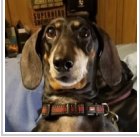
