



Mr. James D. Pollock

August 10, 1925 - November 3, 2013

Graveside services for Mr. James Duncan (Jim) Pollock, Sr., 88, of Longview, formerly of Henderson, will be held at Crims Chapel Cemetery on Friday, November 8, 2013 at 11 am with Rev. David Luckert officiating, under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. The family will receive friends before the service at the cemetery.

Mr. Pollock was born August 10, 1925 in Groesbeck, Texas to Elmer and Armenda Susan (Beaver) Pollock. He was a veteran of WWII having served in the U.S. Navy in the South Pacific. He married Dessie Bell on July 3, 1945 in Dallas, Texas. He died in Longview on Sunday, November 3, 2013.

Henderson, Texas was his hometown from 1951 until 2005 when he moved to Longview. He was employed by Jack Anderson Company in Kilgore, Texas from 1952 until 1974. He retired from Johnston-Lawrence Company in Kilgore in 1993.

Mr. Pollock was preceded in death by his mother, Armenda Pollock, father, Elmer Pollock, and an infant daughter, Susan Ann Pollock.

Survivors include his wife of 68 years, Dessie Pollock of Longview, Texas; his brother, Norman Benson Pollock and spouse, Lyndell of Austin, Texas; son, James D. Pollock Jr. and daughter-in-law, Hettie of Longview; grandsons, Tim

Pollock and spouse, Kristen of Springfield, Virginia and Mark Pollock and spouse, Vicky of Houston, Texas; nephews, Norm Pollock and Mark Lynn Pollock of Austin.

Mr. Pollock was a member of First United Methodist Church of Henderson, Texas; a former member of Henderson-Kiwanis-Alpha where he served as Secretary for a number of years. He was a life-time member of Disabled American Veterans and a member of American Legion Post #288 of Groesbeck, Texas.

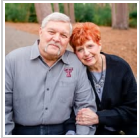
