



Mr. James 'Jitter' Stansbury

June 16, 1940 - August 15, 2013

Memorial services for James 'Jitter' Stansbury, 73, of Lake Striker, will be at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, Aug. 17, 2013 at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home chapel with Rev. Billy Paul Cain and Mr. Leonard Martin officiating.

Mr. Stansbury died Thursday, August 15, 2013 at his residence. He was born June 16, 1940 to Roy Lee and Bertha Ann Stansbury in Clarksville, Tx. He served his country in the US Army during the Vietnam War and was awarded the Purple Heart. He was retired from Anderson Hickey, working there as a Manager.
