Mr. Jerry Smith, 80, of Good Springs, passed from this life to his Heavenly home on March 18, 2025, in Tyler. He was born August 16, 1944, in Longview to the late Rodney and Viera (Wilkes) Smith.

Jerry was raised in Longview and went on to join the U.S. Navy. He served his country honorably for 20 years before retiring from service. After his retirement from the Navy, Mr. Smith worked for Walmart and Extrusions, Inc. in Fort Scott, Kansas.
