Funeral services for LCdr (Ret.) Jessie Henry Kelly, 78, of Henderson, will be held at 2 p.m. Monday, August 10, 2009, at Crawford-A. Crim Chapel with Rev. Tommy Marshall and Rev. Carey Ponder officiating. Interment will be a private family service in Rusk County Memorial Gardens under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Mr. Kelly died Friday, August 7, 2009 at a local nursing home. He was born November 1, 1930, in Big Spring. He was a resident of Henderson since 1991 and was a member of East Side Baptist Church. He was retired from the U.S. Navy and a Korean and Vietnam war veteran. Mr. Kelly was an East Side Baptist Church deacon, Men of Henderson Praying and a member of Rusk County Treasure Hunters. Family will receive friends from 2-4 p.m. Sunday, August 9, 2009, at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. He was preceded in death by his parents, Arthur and Ginger Kelly and brother, Arthur Kelly Jr. Survivors include his wife, Barbara Kelly of Henderson; son, Jess Kelly and wife Elizabeth of Waco; daughters, Tina Forsberg and husband Dan of Greensboro, N.C. and Anita Kelly of Birmingham, Ala.; sister, Pollye Smith of Weatherford, five grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
