Jo Ann was born November 2, 1934 to Lonnie Hubert and Dessie Evelyn King Laney in Troup, Texas and passed away Friday, October 25, 2012 at Hospice of East Texas after a lengthy illness. Jo Ann graduated from Troup High School at the age of 16, then attended Tyler Junior College where she was a member of the Apache Band and also a pianist and singer in a dance band that performed all over East Texas. She also attended East Texas Baptist College in Marshall as a music major before she married the love of her life, Stanley Dulany, on February 27, 1954. They enjoyed 39 years of marriage until Stanley's death in 1993. Jo Ann was an accomplished musician who began playing the piano and organ for First Baptist Church in Troup at the age of nine. As a long-time member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Henderson, she served as church organist playing alongside her daughter Jill for many years until her health failed. Jo Ann loved to travel and visited all fifty states, Mexico, Canada and Israel. She was an excellent cook who loved to entertain, and was a loyal Rangers and Mavericks fan. Jo Ann was a devoted mother who served as a Cub Scout den mother, a Camp Fire Girls leader, and served on countless PTO and band booster boards. She was preceded in death by her parents,
