



Joe Frank Chapman

July 17, 1928 - June 13, 2010

ATHENS - Joe Frank Chapman passed away June 13, 2010. Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday, June 16, 2010, at Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home. Burial will be in Strong Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home in Henderson. Visitation will be from 6-8 p.m. Tuesday, June 15, 2010, at the funeral home. "Joe Frank" was born July 17, 1928, in the Church Hill Community, to Bennie and Lena Chapman. He was a member of Church Hill United Methodist Church and Danville Masonic Lodge No. 101. After graduation from Henderson High School, Joe was employed by Kilgore National Bank and served with the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. In the late 1950s, he became a cattle buyer and stayed in that profession for the rest of his life. Joe helped many people during his life and always insisted that real giving was done in a quiet and often anonymous way. A 37-year cancer survivor, Joe accepted a laryngectomy with dignity and fortitude. His courage and tenacity through the years caused many to admire and emulate him. Joe's love of rodeo and particularly calf roping were legendary. His involvement in the sport began when he was young with his lifelong friend, Sherrill McMurray. His interest continued through his sons' careers in roping. The high point of his life was watching his son, Jeff, set an arena record at the 1997 National Finals Rodeo. Over the years, Joe mentored young calf ropers, many of whom he came to count among his closest friends. Joe loved a good story - both the telling and the hearing of one. He also admired a well-built fence and had a real appreciation of a fine

hand tool. In his later years, he greatly enjoyed his grandchildren. He is preceded in death by: his parents and son, Ben E. Chapman. Survivors are: caring wife and constant companion, Peggy Chapman; son, Jeff Chapman and wife Holly; daughters, Mary Jo Walker and husband Howard and Claudia Hennig and husband Jack; grandchildren, Rachel, Sarah, Daniel, Ben and Jacob; great-grandson, Lucas; sister, Mary Frances McFarland. Serving as pallbearers are Eddie Armstrong, Joe Beaver, Dave Brock, Roy Cooper, Mike McLaughlin and Johnny Powell.
