John Wayne Cochran Sr. passed from this life on May 20, 2024, at his home in New London, TX. He was born February 26, 1955, in Houston. John grew up in the Pine Hill community and graduated from Henderson High School in 1973. He lived almost all of his life in Rusk County. He worked for Texas Utilities, later Luminant, in maintenance at the Martin Creek Power Plant for 35 years before his retirement in 2017. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, and a good game of 42. But his passion was FFA and introducing as many as possible to the program. He spent decades volunteering his free time to the West Rusk FFA and the Rusk County Youth Project Show. He supported countless students with their projects and animals along with raising funds for the West Rusk Buyers Group.

John was preceded in death by his mother Ruby J. Howeth, father Henry Earl Cochran, step-mother Christine Cochran, daughter Brandina Cochran, brother

Samuel Cochran, and wife Lolita Cochran.

Survivors include his children, Tamesha Rude and husband Benjamin, JW Cochran and wife Aimee, Josh Cochran, and Jessica Birss; sister, Nancy Brown; grandchildren, Brandon, Kayla, Michael, Dakota, Dylan, Tristen, ReAnna, Faith, Tre, Krysta, Benji, Avery, Liam, and Dusty due in May; great-grandchildren, Braxten, Hayden, and Stetson. Nothing brought him greater joy than being "PawPaw". He counted dozens more as grandchildren and many kids growing up in the New London area knew him as "PawPaw John".

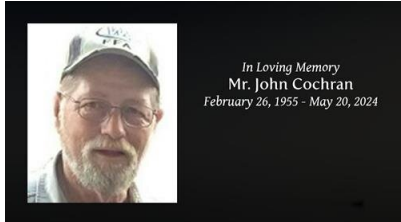
