



## Mr. John M. Roberson

Funeral services for Mr. John M. Roberson, 93, of Troup, will be at 1:00 p.m., Saturday, Nov. 5, 2016 at J - C Cowboy Church in Mt. Selman with Pastor Mike Blumn officiating. Interment with Masonic and Military graveside services will follow at Pinecrest Cemetery in Troup under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home of Henderson.

Mr. Roberson passed away Sunday, October 30, 2016 at Hospice of East Texas in Tyler. He was born October 18, 1923 in Smith County to John and Iva (Bell) Roberson. John enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps on December 9, 1942, and proudly served his country until he retired on April 1, 1968, serving both as an active duty and reserve member of the USMC. John served in the Pacific and American Campaigns during WWII, and was called back to active duty though not deployed for the Korean Conflict. John also worked as a foreman for City Public Service Co. of San Antonio from 1947 until he retired.

He was a Life Member and Past Master of the Davy Crockett Masonic Lodge of San Antonio #1225 A.F. & A.M.. He was a member of his lodge for more than 40 years and worked with the youth organization De Molay as well. John was also a member of, and Past Worthy Matron of two Order of the Eastern

Star Chapters, Alamo Heights Chapter 734 O.E.S. and Henderson Chapter 597 O.E.S. His knowledge and Brotherhood will be greatly missed in these organizations.

He is survived by his wife of 27 years Dorothea Roberson of Troup, TX, his brother Robert Roberson of Houston, TX, daughter Meredith Soape and husband Hugh of Troup, TX, daughter Dianna Taylor and her husband Tom of Friendswood, TX, step-son Jack Smith and wife Kimberly of Troup, TX, 5 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his father John Roberson, mother Iva Roberson, sisters Mary Catherine Moran, Marie Frizzell, wife Beatrice Elizabeth Roberson and step-son Floyd Anthony "Tony" Smith.
