She then attended Southwest Texas State College, now Texas State University, where she received her Bachelor's degree in Music Education. Throughout her life, Judy lived in Austin, Mt. Pleasant, Marshall, and Atlanta and spent the last few years close to family in Ft. Worth. She taught Kindergarten briefly and spent most of her life as a seamstress. She was extremely creative and used her talents to make clothing for her family, color guard uniforms for the high school band, and even upholster furniture for the high school theatre department. Judy was very involved in all of her children's activities throughout their lives.

Mrs. Rousseau loved to travel and go camping with her husband and family.

She also enjoyed gardening and was an avid sports fan, especially if the Dallas Cowboys or Texas Rangers were playing. Judy had a beautiful voice and sang with "The Trion Trio" in her high school and college years. She was always very involved in the church, teaching Sunday School and singing in the church choir. Mrs. Rousseau was a long-time member of Tanglewood Missionary Baptist Church in Atlanta.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Elvin Earl Rousseau, son Duane Rousseau, brother Royce Gladson, and sister Janis Page.
