Judith Kay (Allison) Stuart, 72, was born in Longview, Texas, on November 6, 1940. She passed away on January 13, 2013, in a Henderson nursing home after a long struggle with dementia. Judy was the younger of two children born to Josephine (Munn) Allison and Ross J. Allison. She was preceded in death by her parents. Judy attended White Oak public schools, graduating in 1959. She was very active during her school years, and served as drum major of the band her senior year. She worked at Bodenheim Insurance Agency of Longview and lived in White Oak during the school years of her two sons, Barry and Chris Lassiter. Afterward, she became office manager for Wilson Downhole and finished her career at the Ponder Fishing Tool Company of Kilgore, where she worked over 20 years before retiring. Judy was a member of the White Oak Baptist Church and in recent years frequently attended services at the Church of the Nazarene in Henderson. Judy will be remembered for her sweet disposition and the sparkle in her personality. Judy is survived by her devoted husband of 37 years, Ray Stuart of Henderson. She resided in her home near Henderson until entering the nursing home two years ago to receive the necessary care. Survivors also include two sons and daughters-in-law, Barry Lassiter and
