



Mr. Larry Garner

Services for Larry Garner, 79, of Tyler, will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday, April 29, 2025, at First Methodist Church in Tatum with the Rev. Dwain Smith officiating. Interment will follow at Tatum Cemetery under the direction of Crawford-A. Crim Funeral Home.

Mr. Garner died Friday, April 25, 2025, at his home. He was born Dec. 22, 1945, in Marshall to the late Hubert Garner Jr. and Clara (Wynne) Garner. He was raised in Tatum where he was baptized at First Methodist Church and graduated from Tatum High School in 1964. He served honorably in the U.S. Navy and was stationed on the USS Ranger during the Vietnam War.

Mr. Garner was a modern renaissance man. He had worked with his father as a brick mason, had a career with Bechtel as an engineer, and for many years was the owner and operator of Bodacious BBQ at Exit 562 on Interstate 20. He was also a skilled knife and hat maker as well as a silversmith.

Mr. Garner enjoyed traveling and riding motorcycles. He was a member of the Vietnam Veterans Motorcycle Club and had taken part in the Rolling Thunder ride to Washington, D.C.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his grandparents, Holley H. and Bertha (Kuykendall) Wynne and Hubert E. Garner Sr. and Bessie (Allen) Garner.

Survivors include his wife of nearly 33 years, Diane Garner of Tyler; son, Marshall Neidigh and wife, Emily, and their children Magnolia, Luke and Violet of Blanchard, Oklahoma; sister, Patricia Crisp and husband, David, of Billings, Montana; as well as a host of nieces, nephews and other family and friends. 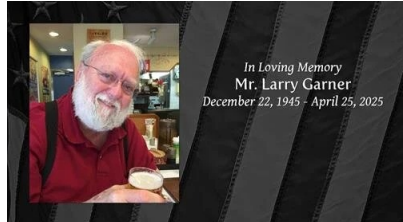

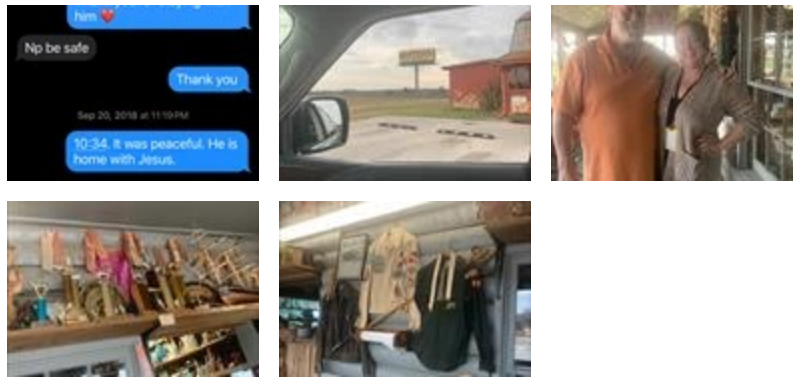
